States adjust allocations, for example, to reflect LEA boundary changes or the creation of new LEAs, including charter school LEAs, that are not accounted for in the statutory calculations. States also are permitted to reserve, for administration, up to 1 percent of the allocations they would receive if \$14 billion were appropriated and generally must reserve 4 percent in fiscal year 2009 for school improvement activities. The 20-percent reservation may include Title I, Part A funds or funding from other Federal, State, local, and private sources. Thus the amount shown in this column reflects the statutory "cap" on per-child expenditures for supplemental educational services.
