I am not sure what comments you are looking for.

My student loan (\$5000 in 1983) has been paid back more than five times. I will never be able to pay the interest (now around \$7000). I was not allowed to pay on the principal.

My stimulation money has been seized. When I overestimated my income for 2008, that was seized.

I am living, primarily, off of Social Security. I have no assets, no savings, no regular income. I am 70 years old.

I can go on about how I was not allowed a deferrment by these people, but at the same time the federal government loan people allowed me one--for continuing education in nursing. I can also describe how losing credit kept me from making more income.

This has been an awful process. I had many student loans before this one and paid them off, but these people lied and made a lot of money off of me.

If you are interested, I can tell you more. It's all been quite discouraging, and I am wearing out.
